Students Guide

What is ARES?

ARES is the library's new reserves repository. It is more robust than the old system, and increases the functionality for students and professors while making the program easier to use.

What are some of the benefits to using ARES?

- Unlike the old system, all students that require access to their Professor's reserve items will need to create an account. This process takes only a few minutes but adds many new features.
- Students will receive email alerts when new items are placed on reserves for your courses.
- Students can create a Hot List to organize readings from multiple classes in one convenient area.

How do I get started?

All students need to create an account to access reserves. First, go to the library homepage http://www.molloy.edu/library


This will take you to the home page of the reserves system. Once you are there choose the 'Create Your Account Now' link on the right hand side as pictured below.


